



Internationalisation

Internationalisation is not just about translating your course materials into English; it is also about supporting your students' learning in a second language, providing an international framework (diversity in your case studies and examples) and developing intercultural competences. We offer several courses for teachers and programme directors in higher education.

Professional development courses

We offer several courses related to the international classroom:

For teachers

Teaching in the International Classroom

This course is aimed at teachers in Higher Education who want to know more about the intercultural and didactic implications of teaching in the international classroom. We will address three aspects: Teaching in a second language, an international framework and intercultural competences with a focus on the specific didactic requirements for small groups, large groups (lectures) and grading and assessment

Effective Teaching in a Second Language

This course is aimed at teachers in Higher Education who want to know more about using English as a medium of instruction and mostly teach Dutch students. The course provides teachers with practical tools to effectively support their students' learning in a second language and focusses on encouraging spoken output and providing feedback on written output.

Developing Intercultural Competences

This course is aimed at teachers in Higher Education who want to know more about the intercultural implications of teaching an international student population. The course supports teachers in developing the necessary skills, knowledge and attitudes to effectively adapt their teaching to the specific needs of a heterogeneous and diverse classroom.

For programme directors

Internationalisation of the Curriculum

This course is aimed at programme directors want to know more about embedding internationalisation into the curriculum. In this workshop we will discuss how you can use an IoC (Internationalisation of the Curriculum) framework to internationalise the learning outcomes of your own programme.

Qualification trajectories

Teaching in Higher Education in an International Classroom

This course is for teachers at Universities of Applied Sciences who want to obtain a teacher qualification with a focus on the International Classroom. The course meetings are planned around themes that are relevant for teaching, course design and assessment.

Teaching Qualification Assessment and Examination in an International Classroom

This course can be followed in addition to the course Teaching in Higher Education in an International Classroom or as a separate course on itself. You will learn how to use tools for designing, administrating and evaluating your own assessments.
