## STUDY AND TESTING FACILITIES

The HU offers support for students with dyslexia, AD(H)D, autism, hearing impairment, fluctuating ability, etc. With support from the student counsellor, you can apply for special facilities, and there are training courses, support groups and financial support opportunities available.

## **Requesting facilities**

Are you studying at the HU (soon) and would you like to apply for suitable facilities? When you registered on Studielink, you may already have indicated which facilities you need and may have contacted the student counsellor about this. Facilities must be requested from the Examination Board. If you want to know more about the facilities you may be able to apply for, please check this HU page or the external website hogeronderwijstoegankelijk if you want to know what your rights are. In addition, you can have a confidential conversation with your student counsellor about this to find out which facilities are suitable for you.

To qualify for facilities, you need an official diagnosis. This could be a medical diagnosis, a dyslexia declaration from a recognised body or from an attending psychologist. The line is only to schedule an appointment, not to answer questions.

Several Facilities Cards are now available: facilities to study successfully and facilities to take a test successfully. Great because that way students know what is available when. After all, if you do not know what there is, you cannot apply for it either. It is important to know that the Facilities Cards only describe standard facilities. In addition, it is possible to find out whether customisation is possible.

## Facilities to study successfully
